



Provision for temporary performance stages/bandstands with in-ground facilities can act as visual highlights and landmarks. Important for Golowan Festival and creation of regular series of events

Improved lighting for the Promenade and highway and to mark all access ramps/gateways. Masts to mount projectors on for animated feature lighting. Could also provide additional banner points.

Promenade as grandstand for increased aerial activities and spectacles

Designed provision of flag/banner poles to enhance length of Promenade and create dramatic visual impact

Telescopes both normal and special where linked to digital media for ongoing programme of short sea inspired films by artists and public

Enhance access points/ramps with paving detail, railings, light features, signage, artworks etc

Promenade as grandstand for increased sea based activities and shows

Opportunities for new lighting to define edges, performance areas and features such as banners

Service points to facilitate performance activities and temporary catering/service kiosks

Occasional detail inserts to new surfacing linked to heritage, contemporary uses, activity focal points

Create new shared surface to Western Promenade Road linking highway to Promenade space and improving access to the seafront

Performance areas defined at intervals along Promenade with seating, lighting, paving, raised platforms and electrical connections

New surface to main Promenade walk

Enhanced secondary seawall incorporating granite and contemporary approach to local style

Incorporate seating into enhanced secondary sea wall/linear artwork

Create additional access points to increase permeability – highlight with artwork detailing

New planting edge to landward side of secondary sea wall and visual link to Alexandra Park
