THE BRIAN SPIEGELHALTER CITIZEN AND YOUNG CITIZEN OF THE YEAR AWARDS

The Town Council has an annual award made to the Penzance Citizen of the Year in recognition of a special service to the community on a honorary basis.

There is also a Youth Award made and the awards will be known as the Brian Spiegelhalter Citizen and Young Citizen of the Year Awards.

The awards are to be made at the Annual Town Council Meeting and each successful nominee will receive a presentation from the Penzance Town Mayor.

CONDITIONS

1. Only residents of the Parish of Penzance, which includes Paul, Mousehole, Newlyn, Gulval and Heamoor, are eligible.
2. Nominations should be made to the Mayor of Penzance on the appropriate nomination form, obtainable from the Town Clerk, Penzance Town Council, Alverton Street, Penzance, TR18 2QP. Office telephone number 01736 363405. Completed forms should be submitted to the Clerk by the 25th April 2008.
3. Persons who are employed, or otherwise paid to provide a service to the community, shall not be eligible to receive an award as far as that service is concerned.
4. An award may be made posthumously.
5. An award shall be granted to the Young Citizen of the Year, ie. any person below the age of 18, and to the Citizen of the Year for anyone above the age of 18.
6. The Mayor will consider the nominations with selected members of the Council and canvassing in writing or in person will disqualify any applicant.
7. Once the decisions have been made, they will be final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding that decision.
8. An unsuccessful nomination can be considered the following year, using the same nomination form - unless there is any further information to add, in which case a new form should be completed.
