1. **PRAYERS**

The Council's Chaplain, Reverend Julyan Drew, offered prayers.

2. **APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE**

3. **ELECTION OF TOWN MAYOR 2007/2008**

Councillor D.J. Axford proposed that Councillor F. Granger be elected to fill the office of
Town Mayor for the ensuing year.

Councillor R. Clark seconded the proposal.

There being no other nominations, the Town Clerk ascertained the views of the members
by means of the Long Vote which entailed the names of the members of the Town Council

5. RETIRING TOWN MAYOR'S REPORT ON HIS YEAR OF OFFICE

The Retiring Town Mayor, Councillor D.J. Axford, reported on his year of office, a copy of which appears as Appendix "E" to the minutes.

The Retiring Town Mayor thanked all those who had supported him through his year of office and concluded by thanking the Town Clerk and all staff for their support throughout the year.

6. VOTE OF THANKS TO COUNCILLOR D.J. AXFORD FOR HIS WORK DURING HIS YEAR OF OFFICE

Councillor S.J. Reed proposed a vote of thanks to Councillor Axford for his year of office. Councillor J.H. Dixon seconded the proposal which was carried unanimously.

7. INSIGNIA OF OFFICE

In accordance with ancient custom, the Town Clerk presented the newly elected Town Mayor with the various insignia of office, stating that they were symbols of the civic traditions of the former Borough of Penzance, having been presented to successive Mayors on acceptance of office over a period of at least half a century. The Town Clerk also explained the purport of the items.

8. ELECTION OF DEPUTY TOWN MAYOR

Councillor F. Granger proposed that Councillor R. Clark be appointed as Deputy Town Mayor for the ensuing year. Councillor M. Freeman seconded the proposal. In the absence of any other nominations, Councillor R. Clark was elected by the Town Council as Deputy Town Mayor for the ensuing year. Councillor R. Clark abstained in the voting. The Deputy Town Mayor then addressed the meeting and announced that his Deputy Mayoress would be Mrs. L. Clark.

9. **THE ELECTION OF CIVIC DEPUTIES**

Councillor C.A.C. White proposed that Councillors M. Freeman and S.J. Reed be appointed as Civic Deputies.

Councillor M. Lovegrove seconded the proposal and in the absence of any other nomination, Councillors Freeman and Reed were appointed as Civic Deputies for the ensuing year.

10. **SERGEANTS AT MACE**

The Town Mayor announced the retirement of Thomas Deryk Chappell after 24 years service. The Town Mayor appointed Trevor Walker and Sid Reed as the two persons to act as Sergeants at Mace until the next Annual Meeting or until others be appointed in their stead. The Town Clerk administered the oath to them.

11. **LE YEOMAN**

The Town Mayor appointed Derek Burstow to act as Le Yeoman until the next Annual Meeting or until another is appointed in his stead. The Town Clerk administered the oath to him.

12. **TOWN CRIER**

The Town Mayor named Mr. P.I.G. Glett as the person to act as Town Crier.

13. **APPOINTMENT OF CHAPLAIN**

The Town Mayor reported that the Reverend Julyan Drew would continue with the duties of Chaplain to the Council.

14. **APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO SERVE ON STANDING AND OTHER COMMITTEES**

Councillor P. Rendle proposed and Councillor J.H. Dixon seconded that the members listed in Appendix "A" to the Agenda be confirmed to serve on the standing and other committees. It was

RESOLVED: that the proposal be carried.

15. **APPOINTMENT OF REPRESENTATIVES TO SERVE ON OUTSIDE BODIES**

Councillor R.M. Lawrence proposed and Councillor M. Lovegrove seconded that those members listed in Appendix "B" to the Agenda be confirmed to serve on outside bodies. It was

RESOLVED: that the proposal be carried.
