1. PRAYERS

2. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

3. ELECTION OF TOWN MAYOR 2010/2011

Councillor J H Dixon proposed that Councillor J Ruhrmund be elected to fill the office of Town Mayor for the ensuing year. Councillor R A Mann seconded the proposal.

5. RETIRING TOWN MAYOR'S REPORT ON HIS YEAR OF OFFICE

The Retiring Town Mayor, Councillor R A Mann, reported on his year of office, a copy of which appears as Appendix "E" to the minutes.

The Retiring Town Mayor thanked all those who had supported him through his year of office and concluded by thanking the Town Clerk and all staff for their support throughout the year.

6. VOTE OF THANKS TO COUNCILLOR R A MANN FOR HIS WORK DURING HIS YEAR OF OFFICE

Councillor J Ruhrmund proposed a vote of thanks to Councillor Mann for his year of office. Councillor C A C White seconded the proposal which was carried unanimously.

7. INSIGNIA OF OFFICE

In accordance with ancient custom, the Town Clerk presented the newly elected Town Mayor with the various insignia of office, stating that they were symbols of the civic traditions of the former Borough of Penzance, having been presented to successive Mayors on acceptance of office over a period of at least half a century. The Town Clerk also explained the purport of the items.

8. ELECTION OF DEPUTY TOWN MAYOR

Councillor M R Cotton proposed that Councillor R A Mann be appointed as Deputy Town Mayor for the ensuing year. Councillor M Lovegrove seconded the proposal. In the absence of any other nominations, Councillor R A Mann was elected by the Town Council as Deputy Town Mayor for the ensuing year. Councillor R A Mann abstained in the voting. The Deputy Town Mayor then addressed the meeting and announced that his Deputy Mayoress would be Mrs Florence Mann.

9. THE ELECTION OF CIVIC DEPUTIES

Councillor M Freeman proposed that Councillors C A C White and P C H Rendle be appointed as Civic Deputies. Councillor P Peters seconded the proposal and in the absence of any other nomination, Councillors White and Rendle were appointed as Civic Deputies for the ensuing year.

10. SERGEANTS AT MACE

The Town Mayor appointed Sid Reed and Peter May as the two persons to act as Sergeants at Mace until the next Annual Meeting or until others be appointed in their stead. The Town Clerk administered the oath to them.

11. LE YEOMAN

The Town Mayor appointed Derek Burstow to act as Le Yeoman until the next Annual Meeting or until another be appointed in his stead. The Town Clerk administered the oath to him.

12. TOWN CRIER

The Town Mayor named Mr. P Rowley as the person to act as Town Crier.

13. APPOINTMENT OF CHAPLAIN

The Town Mayor reported that the Reverend Julyan Drew would continue with the duties of Chaplain to the Council.

14. APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO SERVE ON STANDING AND OTHER COMMITTEES

Councillor D J Axford proposed and Councillor P C H Rendle seconded that the members listed in Appendix "A" to the Agenda be confirmed to serve on the standing and other committees. It was
